You could be spreading invasive species on the trail.

CLEAN YOUR SHOES. STOP INVASIVE SPECIES.

Mud and seeds carry invasive plants. Use the boot brush under this sign to clean off before and after hiking.

HOW TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF HARMFUL PLANTS

- Arrive with clean gear—
 Clean your shoes, clothes, packs and pets before exploring.
- 2. Stay on marked trails to reduce the chance to pick up seeds and mud that carry invasive species.
- 3. Leave with clean gear—Clean your shoes, clothes, packs and pets after exploring.

WHAT ARE INVASIVE SPECIES?

Any organisms that are not native to an area and cause harm.

Invasive species harm native wildlife, habitats and human health.

Invasive species can be spread unintentionally through human activity.
